In accordance of Order No.F.11/79/H&FW/HR-MED/2023#112745287/1877-79 dated 03.10.2024 issued by Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Online applications are invited for recruitment to the post of Junior Resident (MBBS) on ad-hoc & emergent basis for a maximum period of 44 days, which can be extended up to 01 year or till the joining of fresh incumbents on regular basis, whichever is earlier through Google Form link i.e. <https://forms.gle/iTX4Ypy4Gup4CTuJ9> till **12.03.2026 (Thursday) latest by 10:30A.M.**

The interview for following posts will be conducted on **13.03.2026 (Friday) from 10:30 A.M. onwards (Reporting Time for marking attendance: 09.30 A.M. to 10.30 A.M.)**.

The terms & conditions for appointment of Junior Residents (MBBS) are as follows:-

1. Qualification:-MBBS Degree from a recognized University/Institute approved by NMC.
2. DMC Registration:
 - a. The candidate must be registered with Delhi Medical Council at the time of interview; or
 - b. The candidates must be applied for DMC with proper acknowledgement at the time of interview, failing which the candidate will not be allowed to appear:
 - c. The candidates, who have submitted receipt showing that they have applied for DMC registration at the time of interview, should submit valid DMC registration certificate at the time of joining.
 - d. The above criteria may be subject to change depending on prevailing circumstances and the operational status of the DMC.
3. Internship: The candidates, who have completed internship before 13.03.2024 i.e. two years from the date of interview, are not eligible.
4. Admissible Emoluments: Rs.56,100+NPA+other allowances in Pay Level-10 (Index-1) as admissible under the rules of 7th CPC.
5. Citizenship: The candidates should be Indian citizen.
6. Age limit: The age relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates shall be applicable as per instructions of Govt. of India issued time to time. The age eligibility as on date of interview i.e. 13.03.2026 is given below:-

7. Relaxations, in case sufficient fresh candidates are not available:-

General Instructions regarding relaxation of provisions for residency scheme for the Junior Residents vide circular No. F.121/26/2010/H&FW/DSHFW-1996-2045 dated 10.06.2011 issued by the Deputy Secretary (H&FW), Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi are as under (P-2/C) :-

- Upper age limit for eligibility will be 40 years in place of existing 30 years of age (if applied under relaxed category).
- Post Graduates, who are interested to serve as Junior Resident, will be allowed to join as Junior Resident, if fresh graduates are not available.
- Junior Residents, who have completed one year of junior residency, may apply under relaxed criteria. There would be no extension for any Junior Resident beyond one year of appointment under relaxed provisions.
- (i) Separate merit list for fresh candidates and relaxed candidates will be prepared.

(ii) Firstly, the list containing names of fresh candidates would be exhausted for appointment as Junior Resident and second list would be used only after that, if required & fresh graduates are not available.

8. Tenure:

The initial appointment is for 44 days, which can be extended for further 44 days till 01 year after receiving written request from the concerned doctor, which should be duly recommended & forwarded by the concerned HOD. The maximum tenure of Junior Resident Post is 01 year including the previous tenure served in any Govt. Hospital/institute/Organization. The ad-hoc appointment may be terminated earlier on the joining of Junior Residents on regular basis.

Note 2: Candidates, who have already worked in any Govt. Hospital as Junior Resident (MBBS), the period as worked, will be counted to calculate the total period of Junior Residency.

- The number of posts may vary as per incumbency position at the time of interview/declaration of result.
- The applicants are required to fill their details online through Google Form available at the given link. The link of **Google Form will be activated on 09.03.2026 at 03:30 P.M. after approval of Medical Director, GTB Hospital and de-activated on 12.03.2026 at 10:30 A.M.** The applicants should submit the duly signed copy of Google Form along with supporting documents at time of interview.
- In case number of applications is high, the interview may be continued on the next working day(s). The same will be informed to candidates through E-mail.
- No TA/DA will be paid to candidates for appearing in the interview.
- The selection of candidates will be made on the basis of interview merit.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- The entire columns in online application must be filled properly along with prescribed fee of Rs.500/- in the form of Bank Draft (in original) drawn in favour of "PAO-VIII GNCT of Delhi" Payable at New Delhi issued by Delhi Bank Branches in r/o UR & OBC Candidates. The SC/ST/PwD/EWS candidates are exempted from application fee. Application fee will not be refunded in any circumstances. The incomplete applications are liable to be rejected summarily.

- B. Please note that any discrepancy related to documents/information may invite cancellation of candidature as well as it may lead to legal action under relevant provisions of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).
- C. Appointment will be subject to medical fitness and verification of all the relevant certificates of Education Qualification/Age/Caste/DMC registration etc.
- D. The vacancy will be displayed on website of Health & Family Welfare Department, GNCTD and GTB Hospital official website.
- E. The result will be displayed on website of Health & Family Welfare Department, GNCTD and GTB Hospital official website.
- F. Jurisdiction of disputes: In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction of the Court will be Delhi/New Delhi only.
- G. Only OBC candidates of Delhi are eligible for reservation and required to submit their caste certificate along with valid Non Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate issued by the Competent Authority of GNCT of Delhi on or before the last date of application. NCL Certificate for the financial year 2025-2026 is required. OBC (outside Delhi) candidates will be treated as Un-reserved (UR).
- H. SC/ST certificate issued from the Judicial/Revenue-Authorities shall be accepted.
- I. Income & Asset certificate issued from the authorities as per O.M. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt(Res) dated 31.01.2019 issued by DOPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Govt. of India shall be accepted. EWS certificate for the period 2025-2026 is required.
