The Terms & conditions for engagement of Nursing Officer (Contractual) are as follows:-

- (i) The said engagement is purely on contract basis up to 31.12.2021 and it shall be deemed to have automatically come to an end on expiry of the said period.
- (ii) This contractual engagement is purely on temporary basis and it can be terminated by the hospital during the currency of the agreement without assigning any reason or giving any notice.
- (iii) The Hospital reserves the right to change the number of vacancies, withdraw the process in full or part and right to reject any or all applications received without assigning any reasons or giving notice etc.
- (iv) Any unauthorized absence for more than five days will lead to termination of the contract.
- (v) The contractee will sincerely perform the duties assigned to him/her by the Hospital Authorities to the satisfaction of the Hospital Authorities. He/she shall remain polite and courteous to the staff members, patients and their attendants and shall abide by the rules and regulations of the hospital.
- (vi) It will not be the responsibility of the Hospital to provide accommodation to the contractee. The contractee shall not be entitled for any Govt. accommodation.
- (vii) The contractee will not be entitled to financial benefits or concessions as admissible to Govt. Regular Employees.
- (viii) This contractual engagement will not vest any claim or right for regular appointment in this hospital or for continued contractual engagement.
- (ix) The contractee shall be engaged on whole time basis by this hospital and shall not accept any other appointment, paid or otherwise, and shall not engage himself/ herself in private practice of any kind during the period of contract.
- (x) The contractee should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
- (xi) The GTBH reserves the right for deployment of the Nursing Officer (Contract) in GNCTD as per the requirement and directions of H&FW Department, GNCTD.
